THE WINE

- 100% Mauzac
- Some parcels are benefiting from the seaside Mediterranean climate while others are located in the cooler mountains of the Pyrenees

WINEGROWING

- Certified TERRA VITIS, in conversion to organic
- Limestone soils
- Altitude vineyards on the foothills of the Pyrenees, viticulture is dry farming
- Yields of less than 3T/acre

WINEMAKING

- Hand harvest
- Direct slow and low pressure pressing
- Average ageing on the lees of 30 months
- Light dosage 6 g/L (EXTRA BRUT)
- A proportion of "reserve wines" using a solera

- <u>A sustainable project :</u>
 - lightweight bottle (-15%)
 - bottle made from 90% recycled glass
 - bio-sourced label made of natural cotton
